3. CORE ACTIVITIES

3.1. Sanitation Campaigns

- Organize monthly community-wide sanitation exercises across all 15 wards
- Clear drainage channels to prevent flooding
- Clear refuse dumps and maintain public spaces
- Mobilize at least 50 community members per ward for each campaign

3.2. Waste Management

- Promote waste segregation at household level (organic vs. inorganic)
- Establish community composting sites for organic waste
- Advocate for improved waste collection services by local government
- Promote recycling initiatives and upcycling of materials

3.3. Hygiene Promotion

- Door-to-door hygiene awareness campaigns
- Safe water storage education
- Proper sanitation practices (latrine use, handwashing)
- School hygiene clubs and peer education

3.4. Tree Planting & Greening

- Implement annual tree-planting campaigns across all 15 wards
- Target: 1,000 trees per year across Kiru LGA
- Establish green spaces in schools and public places
- Combat desertification through strategic planting

3.5. Environmental Advocacy

- Advocate for enforcement of environmental sanitation laws
- Work with local government on waste management policies
- Document environmental challenges and propose solutions
- Engage traditional leaders in environmental stewardship
