Partnership Opportunities: Waste management equipment, tree seedlings, sanitation training, advocacy support

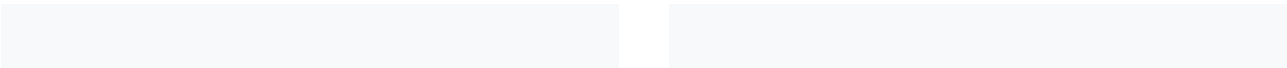
■ 10. Media, ICT & Awareness Community
